

Harrisville Township Trustees Regular Meeting  
8:00 P.M.  
October 3, 2011

The meeting was called to order by vice-chairman Tom Packard. Also in attendance were trustee Richard Indoe, fiscal officer Pat Higgins, road maintenance supervisor Rick Matus, and zoning inspector Hattie Ziegler.

**Minutes :** The minutes of the September 19, 2011 minutes were tabled until the next meeting when Remington and Packard are both present.

**Public Participation:** Bob Hevener from Cloverleaf Schools was present to ask for support of the upcoming levy. The Ohio Department of Education has rated the district as excellent. They are currently operating in the red. Their enrollment has dropped from 3600 to 2800. There have been many cuts already made including elimination of 53 jobs. The levy is 6.5 mills which amounts to \$16.59 per \$100,000 evaluation.

The Village of Lodi has chosen to stay with the Medina County Sheriff's Department for dispatching.

Joanne Slorgie was present to discuss a meeting she attended regarding fracking. ODNR does the inspecting. She stated one Medina County resident has had problems with his water due to drilling. She also advised there is a permit issued to drill in Harrisville Township at Rt. 224 & Congress Road.

**Purchase Orders/Pay Bills:** Indoe made a motion to sign purchase orders and pay bills seconded by Packard. All in favor. Check numbers 4757-4777 were signed.

**New Business:** Packard made a motion for Resolution #12-11 accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor seconded by Indoe. All in favor.

**Zoning Inspector:** There will be a hearing on Oct. 13, 2011, regarding a conditional permit for 8210 Avon Lake Road to allow the resident to put in a mobile home while building a new house. The current house on the property is not habitable. That house will be torn down.

Hattie is waiting to hear from Bill Thorne regarding the solar farm.

**Road Supervisor:** Rick had nothing new to report

**Correspondence:** No action needed

**Other Business:** Indoe advised trustees need to speak to Bill Thorne regarding the wording of the next fire & rescue levy.

There being no further business, Indoe made a motion to adjourn seconded by Packard. All in favor.
